What We Do:

- Provide Assistance to Veterans and their families in completing the VA Benefits process. Such as:
 - Compensation
 - Pension
 - Window's Pension
 - Burial Benefits
 - D.I.C.
 - Clothing Allowance
 - Health Care Enrollment
 - Request Military Records



Compensation Benefits:

- *Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC)*
 - Monthly compensation due to the veteran passing from a service connected disability
- *Service Connected Disability*
 - Monthly compensation for a veteran due to a current disability that occurred while on active duty (have to have medical evidence connecting the two)

Pension Benefits:

- *Non Service Connected*
 - If the veteran is 65, or disabled and served on active duty with at least one day during a war period you can be eligible if you meet the income requirements
- *Widow's Pension*
 - Monthly income for a veterans spouse. (must meet income requirements)
- *Aid and Attendance*
 - Assistance paying for home help or skilled care
(this is in addition to pension or compensation pay)

VA Health Care:

- Service connected disability visits are no charge
- Veterans are eligible due to their income, if not service connected. (Co-pays are based on income)



Burial Benefits:

- A flag and grave marker are provided for every veteran who received an honorable discharge
- If the veteran was receiving a check from the VA at the time of death there is a one time burial benefit available.
