Competitor Procedures

No guns or ammunition are permitted in the building. Please leave them in your vehicle. Holsters are mandatory on the range!

Fill out the Registration Form, Eligibility Affidavit, Liability Agreement (if you have not previously done so), and return forms with payment to Administration. Do not sign Eligibility Affidavit or Liability Agreement until instructed to do so. They MUST be witnessed.

Administration will hand you a Scorecard and Relay & Lane Assignment card. On the Relay Card print your first & last names. Fill out the front of the Scorecard – handgun caliber is required & print your last & first name on the back of the Scorecard. You will be asked if you are sharing your handgun with another person (requiring you be in different relays). Write the name of the alternate person on the top front of your Scorecard.

When you have completed the above, clip the cards back together and turn them back to Administration table.

When Relay & Lane assignments have been completed, you will be called back to the Administration Table. You will receive your Relay Card and a bundle of 3 targets. Print your last name, first name in the top right-hand corner of each <u>target</u> (not on the backer board). Write your Relay & Lane (Target) number on each target in the appropriate space.

The Safety Briefing by the RSO will be given in the building. When that is completed, the RSO will direct you to move down to the range. Pick up your weapon and ammo on your way. The Range Warden will inspect your fire arm at the gate. It, magazines, & speed loaders MUST be empty.

You must report to the Target Manager at the range and give him/her your targets. The Target Manager will check you in and direct you to the Competitors Area.

When your Relay number is called to the Firing Line you will move to the firing line following the instructions of the firing line officers. Handguns must be <u>empty</u> and in your holster!

At this time, you must take commands from the Range Safety Officer (RSO) and Range Officers (RO) and NO ONE ELSE!

Handguns must remain unloaded until explicitly instructed to load them by the RSO! Live rounds cannot be put into the handgun at any location on the range other than the firing line. Magazines or speed loaders may be loaded with 5 rounds of ammunition in not more than two of each.

During the competition, you may enter the building from the north end (towards Chesnee) to use the restroom. You must stay away from the scorers. Getting too close to a scorer may get you disqualified.
