Relay & Lane Assignment Guidelines

Competitors are asked if they are sharing their handgun with another person (requiring them to be in different relays). They must write the name of the alternate person on the top front of their Scorecards.

Using categories 22 rim fire & all other calibers, attempt to have as equal number of each in all relays.

For Lane assignments within a Relay, put smaller caliber handguns on the left side and larger caliber on the right. The lane assignment for small caliber guns should be 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9; for large caliber handguns, the lane assignment should be 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 2, 3, 1; It is also generally better to put anyone using any Glock in the rightmost lane(s).

None of this is absolutely mandatory. If possible, leave lanes between competitor's empty.
